Helping at Home

Letter Names

We are now learning to call letters by their names as well as saying the sounds that they make. Play 'I Spy' using letter names as well as sounds.

Helping at Home

If you are sending a text message to a friend ask your child to help you to spell a word using letter names.

Helping at Home

Create a monster dictionary with your child - make up a scary monster name beginning with each letter of the alphabet and ask your child to draw a picture of what that monster would look like.

Helping at Home

Supermarket ABC

Encourage your child to find words on packaging in the supermarket - start with something beginning with 'a', 'b', 'c' etc.

Helping at Home

Sing an alphabet song together - see if your child can teach you a new one.

Can you sing it fast, slow, forwards and backwards?

Helping at Home

Sing an alphabet song together.

Miss out a couple of letters and see if your child can spot the ones that you missed.

Helping at Home

Cut out pictures from a catalogue or magazine of objects that begin with each letter of the alphabet.

Write a word or message using the objects to spell it and see if your child can crack the code!

Helping at Home

Continue to sing alphabet songs together and encourage your child to spell using letter names.

Play 'I Spy' with letter names - 'I spy something beginning with 'c''
